TOX 490: Independent Study

Cr. 1-2. Repeatable. F.S.SS

Prereq: Permission of instructor is required prior to registration.

Independent study with a faculty mentor. Intended for students enrolled in the Pharmacology and Toxicology minor. Students may use no more than 9 credits of university-wide 490 credits towards the total of 120 credits required for graduation.
